Not speaking English can make people feel isolated, so I had the idea of starting a new church for Swahili-speakers. With the help of CBF field personnel Marc and Kim Wyatt and CBF's New Church Start's Initiative, I have been able to start a church. From there, God started talking to me about how he's going to restore people's lives."

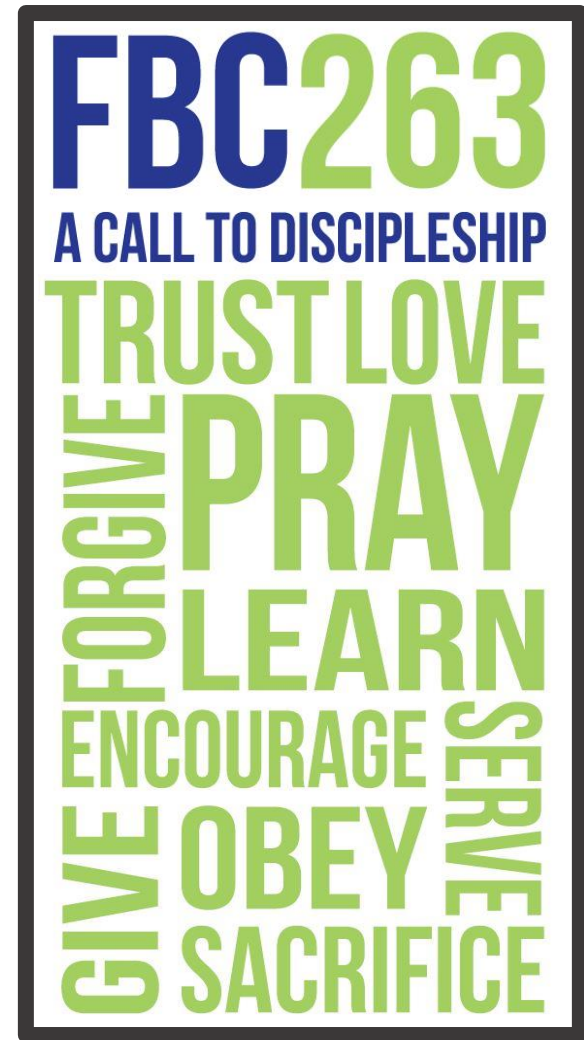
