A couple of years ago, I was contacted by a local councilman about a family in need. The mom had died tragically on Christmas Eve leaving behind a dad and three boys. Dad and the boys were sleeping on a mattress in the living room because the boys were afraid to sleep alone since Mom died. In the middle of the living room floor was a huge hole they had stuffed with old clothes to keep the cold and snakes out. I contacted First Baptist Frankfort about the need, and a group of men came down to replace the floor and the front door. Repairs were also done to the front porch and steps were replaced on the front and back of the home. Another church team came later and built a new bathroom in the home.

We have been able to help the youngest boy enroll in Head Start and he is working with a speech therapist. The middle boy is attending after school programs which has increased his reading level. The oldest boy was assigned a mentor through the high school and is doing better in school. Dad was not employed but could do small engine repairs. We helped him advertise and now he has a steady income. We helped them find a church where Dad and the two oldest boys have accepted Christ.

This story is so important to the Emma Quire Mission Center and FBC Frankfort. So many needs were met and continue to be met in that family because of the first outreach of a repaired floor.
